

CLOTA Volunteer Points-Submit Yours Now

Every single activity that a person does for CLOTA has a point value, based principally on the amount of time it takes for the job. When a person reached 10 points, that person becomes an *Honor Volunteer* and receives a drama mask pin.

Points are given for taking part in productions, of course, but they are also given for other activities:

- working at a building clean-up day;
- being a CLOTA member or a financial donor;
- promoting CLOTA at a club or organization's meeting in the valley
- attending a theatrical production in the valley;
- baking for intermission sales;
- coming to membership meetings in October and January;
- being on a committee or task force;
- working on fundraising;
- ...

You get the idea.

Points are cumulative, and there is no end to the opportunities to earn more. Go through the list of activities posted on the CLOTA website, mark those you have done and how often (which shows, etc.), and email our list to Barbara Roberts now. Pins will be awarded at the banquet on Jan. 21. If you have helped in ways not on the list, write them down too. They count!
